On October 14, 1998, ([63 FR 55177](#)) the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) proposed a consolidated rulemaking containing several elements: a generic MACT standards program for small (less than five) source categories, general control requirements for certain types of emission points for Hazardous Air Pollutants, and finally, specific MACT standards for four source categories. The proposed rulemaking is posted at our website (<http://tis-nt.eh.doe.gov/oepa>) under the "What's New?" button for your review. The notice's first page summary is attached for your information. We would appreciate your comments and input on this proposed rulemaking via memorandum, fax or e-mail by January 4, 1999.
